

Summer Band Survival Items!!!

- > Instrument & accessories
- ➤ Music (including flip folder)
- ➤ ½ Gallon Red Water Jug
- ➤ Light weight and light-colored clothing
- Tennis shoes (absolutely no sandals, flip flops!)
- ➤ Hat, sunglasses, and sunscreen

Because summer band can be an extremely physically demanding event, it is highly recommended that students take the proper precautions to stay healthy. Here are some tips to have a more pleasant experience!

- o **Stay hydrated!** Drink plenty of water and juices. The more that you consume, the less likely you are to suffer heat exhaustion or even heat stroke. Stay away from carbonated beverages!!!
- Eat healthy meals! Stay away from greasy junk food and consume more fruits and vegetables. Also, don't forget to eat a good breakfast. You will be working very hard in the heat, so don't try to run on an empty stomach.

Enrichment Fee and Usage

The Aubrey Band has adopted an Enrichment Fee that ensures that our band students all contribute to the necessary expenses that go with being a member of our organization. Although our band is well funded through the AISD, the needs of our students exceed the amount budgeted for our band program.

Students will be responsible for a \$90 enrichment fee. The fee will cover the expense of a portion of the marching band show design and clinicians and techs throughout the school-year.

Pay your band fees with a credit card!

Required Physical for Marching Band

All marching band students are required to have a physical examination before participating in marching band rehearsals. The UIL is requiring all students to have one on file with the district before rehearsals begin on July 29 (July 26 for 9th graders). All students are expected to bring his/her pre-participation physical examination form signed by a physician, a physician assistant licensed by a state board physician assistant examiner, a registered nurse recognized as an advanced practice nurse by the board of nurse examiners, or a doctor of chiropractic to registration on July 25. Examination forms signed by any other health care practitioner will not be accepted. Students who do not do so, will not be allowed to participate in marching band rehearsals. Please fill out the form below and bring it to your scheduled physical examination. Once this has been completed, you can either email it to me or bring it on registration day, July 25.

All students will also have to have a medical history form turned in before participating in marching band rehearsals. These will be turned in during registration along with the physical exam form.

Since percussion and color guard camp take place before registration, color guard and percussion students will need to complete your physical and medical history form and bring them both with you to the first day of camp, July 19.

Note: If you are in athletics and band, you will NOT need a separate form for each activity. Also, if you received a physical last year, you will not need to complete a physical until next year. (Physicals are required every 2 years.)
