

# Aubrey High School Band April 27-30, 2023

## Thursday, April 27th (travel day)

**6:00am** Band hall opens, all bags will be inspected by chaperones before loading **6:30am** Load and depart for Corpus Christi. Fast food lunch stop along the way. You will need to cover the cost of this meal.

Stop at Super HEB (Waldron Rd & S Padre Island Drive) to get food for your condo meals (you will need to cover 3 breakfasts, 2 lunch, 2 dinner, and snacks)

**3:30pm** Check in to condos, dinner on your own (Gulfstream Condos, 14810 Windward Dr)

<u>Friday, April 28<sup>th</sup></u> (performance and beach day) Breakfast in your condo. Morning performances at Flour Bluff High School. Back at condos for lunch and rest of day at the beach.

**10:30** Warm up

11:00 Performance

11:30 Load/Depart for condos

# Saturday, April 29th (full day at beach/condo)

We will have a cookout at the beach! This dinner will be provided to you...thank you band boosters!!!

<u>Sunday, April 30<sup>th</sup></u> (morning at beach) Breakfast in your condo. You have the option of spending a little bit of time at the beach in the morning.

**11:00am** Eat lunch at Whataburger (121 N Shoreline Blvd, Corpus Christi) This meal will be paid for via the AISD district budget.

**12:00pm** Depart for Aubrev

7:30pm Arrive Aubrey High School

## Items to bring:

Instrument, music, mutes, percussion equipment, beach towel, sunscreen, aloe vera, hat, sunglasses, small ice chest, toiletries, beach attire, frisbees, footballs, volleyball

#### Clothes:

We will wear our marching show shirts, jeans, and tennis shoes for the performance. Beach and pool attire will be conservative; no bikinis and speedos!

### **Money to bring:**

You will need to cover Thursday/Friday dinner, Friday/Saturday/Sunday breakfasts, Friday/Saturday lunches, and any snacks you will want. When shopping at HEB, shop with your roommates to lower the cost. I recommend you bring \$50-75 to cover all meal costs. The only restaurant meal you will need to pay for is Thursday's fast-food lunch stop. Saturday's dinner and Sunday's lunch will be covered for you.

## All medications (prescription and over the counter)

MUST be placed into its original container and then into a zip lock bag and must be accompanied by a NOTE from a parent with detailed instructions and permission to use the medication. All medication will be turned into the designated administrator or chaperone before the trip and will be dispensed by that administrator or chaperone.

### Condo items supplied:

bath towels (6 per unit that must be there at time of checkout), sheets, pillows, blankets, bath soap, dish soap, toilet paper, paper towels, trash bags, pots & pans, dinnerware & glassware, silverware & cooking utensils, cookware, microwave, coffee maker, toaster, blender, measuring cups & spoons

#### Condo items NOT supplied:

beach towels (not to use bath towels at beach), sunscreen, shampoo and conditioner, and per Texas law – no food products (including oils, spices, even salt and pepper).

#### Rules to Follow:

- 1. You are to be with all of your roommates and designated chaperone when leaving the condo going to and from the beach and/or pool.
- 2. When at the beach, you will only be allowed to go into the water waist deep. No further!
- 3. Room inspections may occur at any time by a chaperone or director.
- 4. Any damage of condo property will become the financial responsibility of the person or persons involved.
- 5. Students will report to, and remain in, assigned rooms from curfew to breakfast hour without exception. Emergencies will be reported immediately to a chaperone or director. In the event of fire, please evacuate immediately and assemble in the parking lot near the bus.
- 6. Orders or directions from chaperones will be obeyed as if a director gave them.
- 7. No member of the opposite sex will visit a room at any time. This includes "just talking" in the doorway.
